

1926 Australian Ladies' Rowing Council meeting

April 29, 1926 held at the Clark Boat House, Kangaroo Point, Brisbane.

Regret was expressed that the other affiliated states had not replied to the intimation forwarded them or the date of the race or to the receipt or the Rules forwarded.

Miss Connor, having forwarded an affiliation fee for the Albert Park Club and the resignation of the said club not having been received on the affiliation of the Victoria Ladies Rowing Association, the Acting Hon. Sec. was asked to write and find out the position of the Victorian representatives on the Council.
