Miss M. Reid QLD. was elected to the chair.

Boats: Miss Hillmier moved that all women's races be rowed in tubs in view of certain difficulties appertaining to the borrowing of' clinkers both for training and racing. Motion lost.

Miss Goodman moved that Rule 3 of Rules be amended to read as follows:

"That the race be rowed at Brisbane, at Tasmania, at Sydney, at Perth, at Adelaide, at Melbourne and shall be continued in that order". Carried.

Miss Goodman moved that each coxswain be weighed on entering the boat and the winning coxswain be weighed on leaving the boat. Carried.

The four clubs in S.A. share equally the affiliation fee of 10 3/8 as no association is existent in South Australia. Motion lost.

That each club in South Australia or any other state not having its own Association pay affiliation fee of 10/- and the Council deal direct with each club individually. Carried.

A.L.R.C. Rules Revision

10. Moved by Miss Goodman that a copy of the existing rules of the Council be sent to each State with a request to the various associations that suggestions for alterations, additions etc. thereto, be forwarded to the State Association conducting the race in 1933 (i.e. Tasmania) all such suggestions to be submitted at 1933 A.L.R.C. meeting to be held in that state such meeting to have full authority to revise the rules as they think fit. Carried.

Moved by Mrs. Pittman that a copy of the minutes of this meeting be sent to each and every association or club affiliated. Carried.
