## 1936 Australian Ladies' Rowing Council meeting

Discussion arose regarding the admission of the two Bundaberg delegates to the conference. Mrs. Farr moved seconded Mrs. Peters that both clubs from Queensland return to their own state for this year to thrash the matter out and be not admitted to enter in the race. An amendment moved by Mrs. Bradley seconded Miss Enis that both clubs are not out of order and as we had accepted Brisbane affiliation that they be allowed to compete in the race. Carried.

Notice of motion from Victoria: any girl transferring from one stata to another will not be eligible to row with a new state unless she produces a clearance from the State she has first left. Carried.

Alteration to Rule 8: The Sec. and Treas. shall keep account of the funds of the Council. Accounts to be operated on by Hon. Sec and Treasurer. The Treasurer shall submit an audited financial statement at annual meeting (to be added to same) rule. All bank books forwarded intact. Carried.

Alteration to Rule 6: The Sec. and Treas. of the Council shall be sec. and Treas. of State Association.

Addition to Rule 10.: Each state association shall pay an affiliation fee to Hon. Sec. of Council of 10 /- three months before race.

Rule 5: From Victoria. - the latter part of Notice of Motions to read 4 weeks instead of 8 and General Business to be added.

From S.A. Rule 5: the latter part of notice of motions to read 6 weeks instead of 4 but no general business.

From Tasmania - new rule - that any state unable to provide racing clinkers be not granted the right to hold the Australian Championship for women.

That no coach or official connected with the competing crew be appointed to officiate at the Australian Championship. The result of the last named 4 rules owing to secretary omitting to send copies to other states delegates to take same to their Association and result recorded by postal vote. Moved Miss Ellis seconded Mrs Mercer.
