COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE:

- Four lanes will be used on the course, three crews (station 2, 3 and 4) rowing through the Centre arch of the Barwon Bridge and one crew (station 1) through the North arch.
- Stations will be numbered from the North side (boat shed side) of the river.
- Yellow lane marker buoys (4 per set) will be placed - one set on the East side of the Barwon Bridge, and two sets on the West side of the Barwon Bridge, and the courses through the buoys shall be - Station 1: between North Bank and No.1 Buoy; Station 2: between No.1 Buoy and No.2 Buoy; Station 3: between No.2 Buoy and No.3 Buoy; Station 4 between No 3 Buoy and No.4 Buoy.
- Yellow numbered course marker discs will be placed on the East side of the Barwon Bridge.
- Yellow numbered course marker discs will be suspended over the course at approximately the finishing line.
- Marker buoys (yellow) will be placed on both sides of the course at the 1000 metres and 1,500 metre marks. Crews will be required to race inside the buoys at these two points.
- Toggle starting arrangements will be installed at the start.
- Crews may NOT use the course for practice starts etc. after the commencement of the regatta.
- Accommodation of Competitors - notices will be placed on both the Corio Bay Rowing Club and the Barwon Rowing Club indicating the names of competing clubs which are to use their facilities, and all competitors are requested to comply with the allocations made by the host Clubs concerned.
