

CONDUCT OF THE REGATTA

 There will be regatta briefings on Friday at 9.15am and 5.15pm outside the GRA shed in the Boatshed reserve. Each school is to provide a representative.

COXSWAINS – Weight Check

Thursday: Fourth & Fifth Crews weigh in at 4.00pm. **Friday:** First, Second and Third Crews weigh in at 9.15am. Weight of Coxwains: Boys Firsts 54kg, Seconds 51kg, Thirds, Fourths and Fifths 50kg. All girls 50kg. The official scales are situated in the Geelong College Shed.

- Crews must <u>leave the staging</u> at least 20 minutes before the advertised time of the particular race in which
 they are competing.
- 4. When crews leave the shed to go to the start, they must proceed downstream of the turning buoys before turning upstream and proceeding to the start by the SOUTH SIDE OF THE RIVER. Whilst proceeding to the start all crews must stop when 100m ahead of any approaching race.
- 5. THE STARTER MUST DISQUALIFY ANY CREW NOT AT THE STARTING LINE AT THE ADVERTISED STARTING TIME, unless he has been officially informed that for some good reason the starting time of the race has been delayed. Any such delay will not affect the starting time of the remainder of the programme.
- STATIONS No. 1 is on the north side of the river, No. 2 is the north centre, No. 3 is the south centre, No. 4 is the south side of the river.
- 7. If any breakage of material occurs within the first 100m of any race, that race will be restarted.
- 8. The Coxswain (*where possible*) and Bow of each crew will wear a number indicating the number of the crew, ie, Crews competing in First Crews of each school will wear No. 1, in Second Crews No. 2, in Third Crews No. 3, in Fourth Crews No. 4, and in Fifth Crews No. 5.
- 9. The course is marked by buoys and all crews shall steer a course as indicated. In the event of a crew failing to keep to its course throughout the race and interfering with the true course of another competitor or obtaining an unfair advantage, it could be subject to disqualification at the discretion of the umpire.
- 10. During the progress of each race broadcast descriptions will be given over the Public Address System.
- 11. The result will be announced over the Public Address System after each race.
- 12. In the event of a dead heat in any final the race will not be re-rowed.
- 13. Boys' Crews For all 11 boat entries the relevant FISA system will be used. Winners will be drawn in lanes 2 and 3 and second placegetters will be drawn in lanes 1 and 4. As far as possible this lane system will be used for all events.
- All boys crews will compete using a system of repechages determined by the number of crews in the event.
 See pages 21 and 22.
- 15. Girls' Crews Where five crews are entered there will be two heats and the first placegetter in each heat will row in the Division A Final. All other placegetters will row in the Semi-Final. The first and second placegetters in the Semi-Final will row in the Division A Final and the third crew in the Semi-Final will be eliminated.
- 16. Where four crews are entered there will be two heats on the Friday to determine lanes for Saturday's Final. Where less than four crews are entered there will be a First and Final only.
- 17. During the ensuing year THE FAIRBAIRN CHALLENGE CUP will be held by the winning crew of the Boys' Head of the River and the GEELONG LADIES CHALLENGE CUP by the winning crew of the Girls' Head of the River.
- 18. After the programme is complete, cars should leave the south bank as follows:

To Melbourne: leave via the river bank and follow the road west along the river.

To the Western District: leave via the Common.

 TOILETS – South Bank – 1 permanent block for females and males at the west end of the reserve and two temporary blocks in the reserve for females.

North Bank - Upstream of the McIntyre footbridge.

(There are no public toilet facilities in the Boat Shed area.)

 FIRST AID – First Aid is available on the South Bank near the Moorabool Street Bridge and in the Boat Shed area.

A BRIEF HISTORY

In 1868, John C. Field, on behalf of Mr. Morrison's pupils at Scotch College, challenged Dr. Bromby's pupils at Melbourne Grammar School to a "friendly four oar gig race to be rowed from the Botanical Bridge to Edward's Boathouse (Princes Bridge)". Recent research about this race on the Yarra has shown the Scotch Crew was stroked by J. Brady (not John Field as previously stated). On the 18th June Scotch won the race and since then the "Head of the River" race, as it is now known, has been contested every year. The race was first rowed on the Barwon in 1879 and then every fifth or sixth year until 1916. Between 1921-1943 the Barwon saw it every fourth year and since 1948 the only use of the Yarra was in 1957 when Geelong College won. During World War 2 the Geelong Schools rowed a heat on the Barwon and the four Melbourne Schools rowed heats on the Yarra. These races were held after school, the winners met on the Yarra to decide the title except in 1943 when restrictions on travel were in force. From 1868 to 1897 racing was in fixed seat, four oared gigs, from 1889 to 1900 in sliding seat single streak outrigged fours and from 1901 to 1918 in sliding seat clinker built eights. Shells have been used since.

Scotch College has been represented every year, gradually other schools have joined in, the most recent being Haileybury College who entered the First Eight event for the first time in 1991.

The first cup for competition was presented in 1875 by the Hon. T.J. Sumner, to become the property of the school which should first win it three times. Scotch College won it in 1875, 1876 and 1879 and have retained it since that date.

In 1911 Mr. C. Fairbairn presented the Challenge Cup and the winners of this handsome trophy and previous "Winners of the Race", as it was known then, are listed in this programme.

The Head of the River races have weathered such difficulties as flooded rivers, disputes over ages, dead heats, disqualifications, the accidental drowning of a crew member during training and even the inability of a school to round up enough rowers to boat a crew.

Before World War 2, only the first crew of each school took part in the Head of the River Regatta, but there was a race for second crews and sometimes third crews raced on the Saturday prior to the Head of the River race.

In the early part of the century the race was held in October, but later it was moved to May and after World War 2 to April. When the race was in October it was possible for a boy to represent his school in Football, Cricket, Rowing and Athletics in the one year, as the latter were held in May after the Cricket season had ended.

The first girl to row within the APS was a lone sculler from Geelong Grammar School in 1972. By 1975 there were 32 girls rowing and talk of girls competing at the Senior Regatta which, in fact, happened in 1981 when Geelong Grammar and Geelong College competed with MCEGGS, Morongo and Lauriston in 1st and 2nd Fours over 800m on the Friday. MLC and Carey joined the racing in 1982, with Carey boating a First Four in 1983. In 1984 there were seven girls' crews rowing in each of 1st, 2nd and 3rd Four events but in the next year the regatta reverted to an all APS affair with only GGS and GC boating a First Four. In 1986 Carey reappeared in the First Fours and Wesley joined, so, finally, with Caulfield joining in 1987, all five co-educational schools were boating a first four over 1500m. The first three girls' crews now use racing boats over 1500 metres and many of those who have competed have gone on to National and International success. In 1995 fourth and fifth girls' crews were introduced, racing over 1000m in regulation fours.

The schools take part in a number of V.R.A. Regattas, including those at Ballarat, Geelong, Footscray, Carrum and Melbourne while the Junior Crews compete in V.R.A. and A.P.S. School Regattas and the A.P.S. Junior Regatta. The girls regularly compete at the Head of the Schoolgirls whilst many crews compete, when practical, for both State and National titles,

Repechages are used for all boys' crews to give losing crews in the heats a chance to row in the Division A Final. Too often, in the past, two of the best crews have been in the same heat. All boys' crews now row over 1500 metres in racing boats.

Each year the A.P.S. Delegates' Committee invites winning 1st crews of 50 and 40 years ago to the Regatta. This year representatives of the winning 1946 Scotch College and 1956 Geelong College crews are here as guests.
