NOTICE TO ALL CREWS

The Regatta will be conducted in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the New South Wales Rowing Association.

Each member of a crew must be eligible in accordance with Rule 46 Status of Oarsmen.

Substitutes in crews, including coxswains, must be advised to the Starter and Judge as provided in Law 6 of the Laws of Boat Racing.

At the Start No.1 position is on the right-hand side looking from the starting point towards the finish.

All crews must be in the Starter's hands 5 minutes before the advertised starting time.

In races involving heats all crews are to report to the Starter five(5) minutes before the starting time for the first heat. Finals for all events will be held in the order laid down on Regatta Card.

Start and finish will be by gunfire. Recall signal by Starter will be one gunshot. Stop signal by Umpire will be by waving red flag.

All Senior and Junior races will be over a distance of 2,000 metres, all other events will be conducted over a distance of 1,500 metres.

For all events except Championship races, all winning crews proceed to the staging immediately under the Judges Stand for the presentation of Trophies. Presentation of Championship Trophies will be made immediately after the running of the Champion Vlll's, at the dais in front of the official enclosure.

NEW ZEALAND COLTS TOUR 1971

The New South Wales Rowing Association welcomes the New Zealand Colts visit to Sydney and sees it as a forerunner to annual competition between New Zealand and this State.
